The Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs will hold a public hearing on Thursday, March 14, 2013, at the Corporation, Securities, and Commercial Licensing Bureau, 2501 Woodlake Circle, Okemos, Michigan in Conference Room 3 at 9:00 a.m. The hearing will be held to receive public comments on proposed changes to the Administrative Rules for Architects, Professional Engineers, and Professional Surveyors.

The proposed rule sets (2009-065 LR, 2009-032 LR, and 2009-038 LR) will establish criteria to implement and administer continuing professional competence for licensees at time of renewal pursuant to MCL 339.2009, 1980 PA 299.

These rules are promulgated by authority conferred on the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs by sections 205, 308, and 2009 of 1980 PA 299, being MCL 339.205, 339.308, and 339.2009; and, Executive Reorganization Order Nos. 1996-2, 2003-1 and 2008-4, being MCL 445.2001, 445.2011, and MCL 445.2030. These rules will take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
